About Us

OAWD is a unit of the Central Valley Project. The District was formed in 1954. The District started water deliveries in 1977. By 1983 the District was completed and delivering water throughout its borders. The District serves about 29,000 acres using 110 miles of pipeline and over 300 metered deliveries in the Orland and Artois area in the Sacramento Valley. OAWD receives water from 5 diversions off of the Tehama Colusa Canal. The TC Canal diverts water from the Sacramento River in Red Bluff and ends in Dunnigan, about 120 miles south. The District has a contract with the Bureau of Reclamation for 53,000 acre-feet of water annually. This amount can be reduced in drought years. The District water is for agricultural irrigation purposes only.

Water for the Current year must be applied for by April 30th . Water Application requires paying the water advance, payment of 1st installment of Operation Charge, and no past due bills on account .

Distribution System Assessment 2021

The District was built using a 9D loan from the USBR which was paid off in 2020. The DS Assessment pays back the bank loan and will be paid off in 2035.

Annual Charge

\$21.76 per Acre

- Paid for in 2 Installments due June 1st and October 1st.
- Delinquent payments will receive a 5% penalty.
- The DS Assessment is to be paid annually, regardless of water use.

CVP Construction Charge 2021

In 2020, the District paid off the 9E loan to the USBR. The CVP Construction Charge pays back the bank loan used for payout and it will be paid off in 2035.

Annual Charge

\$23.00 per Acre

- Paid for in 2 Installments due June 1st and October 1st.
- Delinquent payments will receive a 10% penalty.
- The CVP Construction Charge is to be paid annually, regardless of water use.

Operations Charge 2021

The Operations Charge pays for O&M for the District and the District's share of TCCA O&M.

Annual Charge

\$40.74 per Acre

- Paid in 2 Installments due April 1st and August 1st.
- Delinquent payments will receive a 10% penalty.
- The Operation Charge is to be paid annually, regardless of water use.
