RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PER-ACRE VALUATION FOR DISTRICT LANDS

AS A BASIS AND PREMISE for this Resolution, the Board of Directors of ORLAND-ARTOIS WATER DISTRICT finds and states as follows:

- 1. After due and legal notice was given, a public hearing having been conducted on this date by the Board of Directors of ORLAND-ARTOIS WATER DISTRICT for the purpose of hearing evidence on its proposed per-acre valuation for District lands, to be adopted in accordance with the alternative valuation provisions set forth in California Water Code Sections 36577 and 36578; and,
- 2. Having heard and considered the evidence and having determined that it is in the best interests of the District,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED, ADJUDGED and ORDAINED that:

All the lands of ORLAND-ARTOIS WATER DISTRICT are of a single class, and, based upon the proportional and relative benefits received by those lands by reason of the existence and operation of the District, all those lands shall be valued, for purposes of District assessments, at \$100 per acre.
