RESOLUTION NO. 2016-06

RESOLUTION COMMENCING ALTERNATIVE ASSESSMENT PROCEDURE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017

AS A BASIS AND PREMISE for this Resolution, the Board of Directors of ORLAND-ARTOIS WATER DISTRICT finds and states as follows:

- 1. By means of its Resolution Number 86-4, adopted September 9, 1986, this Board of Directors elected that ORLAND-ARTOIS WATER DISTRICT would use the alternative assessment procedure provided by California Water Code Sections 36577 and 36578.
- 2. It is necessary now to begin the process for the assessment which will be levied for the 2017 fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED, ADJUDGED and ORDAINED that:

- 1. Based upon the proportional and relative benefits bestowed on the District's lands by reason of the existence and operation of the District, and the fact that the entire District's land is agricultural and receives direct District benefits, the Board of Directors proposes to adopt a \$100-per-acre valuation for all those lands.
- 2. November 15, 2016 at 1:30 p.m. at the District Office at 6506 Road 27, Orland, California, is set as the date, time and place for a public hearing at which owners of property or residents of the District may appear and be heard on the valuation schedule proposed to be adopted for all District lands.
- 3. The District Secretary is directed to give all the appropriate notices required by Water Code Section 36578.
